DAY TRIP TO HELSINKI 13.07.2013



In the morning at 07:30 you will take a ferry to Helsinki from Tallinn Dterminal.Arrival to Helsinki is at 09:30. Your guide will meet you in Länsisatama and take you to city center for a walking tour.

Walking tour at the Senate Square area (3 hours): An insight into the history of Finland and Helsinki. The beautiful white Cathedral by the Senate Square, The Helsinki University and the library, Council of

States, Bank of Finland, House of Estates, State Archives, House of Nobilities, Main Guard Building and Presidential Palace.

After walking tour you can enjoy free time – go shopping, have lunch, visit Finish design museum etc.

Ferry will depart from Länsisatama at 19:30. Arrival to Tallinn at 21:30.

Price per person is 68 \in . Price includes ferry tickets, breakfast buffee on ferry, guide services for 3 hours in Helsinki. Please have 8 \in cash for tram tickets in Helsinki. For an extra charge there is entrance to museums. Group minimum is 10 persons.

CRUISE TO STOCKHOLM 19.07-21.07.2013



Ferry to Stockholm will depart from Tallinn D-terminal 19.07 at 18:00. Arrival to Stocholm is 20.07 at 10:00 by the local time. . Your guide will meet you in port and take you to city center for a walking tour.

Walking tour (3 hours):


Stockholm, one of the most beautiful capitals in the world, is built on 14 islands connected by

57 bridges. You will visit Stockholm City Hall, climb the City Hall tower for a fantastic view of Stockholm, see Gamla Stan, Stockholm's oldest attraction and one of the best preserved medieval city centers in the world. Walk will take you through small winding streets lined with stores full of handicrafts, antiques, art galleries and cafés. The Royal Palace and Stockholm Cathedral are also located in Gamla Stan.

After walking tour you can enjoy free time.

Price per person is 83 \in . Price includes place in a 4 person cabin, breakfast bufee on ferry on 20.07, guide services for 3 hours in Stockholm. Please have $12 \in$ cash for Tallink transfer from port to city center and back. For an extra charge there is entrance to museums. Group minimum is 12 persons.

3 DAY TRIP TO ST. PETERSBURG 02.07-04.07.2013



DAY 1

Departure at 6:00 from any convenient place for you. Through the bus trip guide is talking about the history of St. Petersburg as a culture capital. Crossing the Russian border in Narva. First, you will be driving to the city to Peterhof fountains and walk in a beautiful park. Admission is for extra charge. The opportunity to visit the park after dinner. On the way you will pass the city center of St. Petersburg .

DAY 2

A city of palaces and museums, broad avenues and winding canals, St. Petersburg's short history has endowed the city with a wealth of architectural and artistic treasures. Alongside world-

famous attractions such as the Hermitage, St. Isaac's Cathedral and the Mariinsky Theatre, the city has scores of lesser known but equally fascinating sights that reveal both the pomp and extravagance of St. Petersburg's political and Imperial past, and also the mysterious, tragic genius that has touched so many of the city's great artists and writers.

Guide will take you to 3 hour city tour and after that you can visit city on your own. For an extra charge it is possible to visit Hermitage (needs to be booked in advance).

DAY 3

After breakfast there is half day for to see more St. Petersburg. Can be agreed if you wish to stay in city center and visit some more museums. Other option is to go and explore Tsarskoe Selo. The town of Pushkin, which surrounds the Tsarskoe Selo estates, is St. Petersburg's most charming suburb. Renamed in Soviet times to honour Russia's greatest poet, the town has numerous sights connected to Alexander Sergeevich, including a museum in the former Imperial Lycee, where he was schooled. Like Peterhof, Tsarskoe Selo is one of St. Petersburg's must-see attractions.

Price per person is 185 \in . Price includes bus service for 3 days, tour guide service, accommodation in hostel (rooms for 4-10 persons), breakfast, city tour. For an extra charge there is visa, health insurance, entrance to museums, lunch, dinners.

Visa cost for US citizens is starting from 165 €/per passport (price is valid in Russian embassy in Tallinn). Price may change any time when embassy changes tariffs. It takes 3 weeks to apply visa.

Minimum group size is 20 persons.
