



## How to find a supervisor?

1. Choose your area of interest.

- **4.** Choose the professor according to your area of interest, in order to work under his/her supervision.
- **5.** Write an email communicating your interest in his/her research and share your study plan with your ideas, as well as, ask him/her for an appointment and further interview.
  - ✤ We recommend writing the subject of your email in Chinese, using Baidu, Bing, Google or any translation system.
  - ✤ Attach your CV, study plan, and transcripts.
- **6.** If the professor does not reply your email, do not need to give up. You can call his/her office and talk to him/her in person. Do not forget to send your CV, study plan, and transcripts.
